

SPONSOR-A-TRAIL MEETING THE CHALLENGE

The San Bernardino National Forest Off-Highway Vehicle (OHV) system is one of the best in California. The Forest offers 36 miles of 24"-50" trails, an additional 169 miles of Forest roads available to green-sticker and red-sticker vehicles, and more than 900 miles of road open for SUV/4x4 travel (104 miles of which are 4x4 routes) that wind through terrain ranging from high desert to chaparral to dense forest.

These trails are used and enjoyed by seasoned riders looking for a challenge, novices building skills, tourists and locals exploring the spectacular back-country. The San Bernardino National Forest OHV system is within close reach of more than 20 million people and receives more use than any other National Forest OHV system in Southern California. This combination of popularity and accessibility has led to an unprecedented need for restoration, maintenance and patrol.

Decreasing budgets and competing interests have left the Forest Service with limited resources to address the issues of extensive and irresponsible use, and the resulting resource damage. In extreme cases, such as the Baldy Mesa, increased demand, in a system adjacent to a growing urban area, create the threat of OHV areas being closed down. The system needs restoration, patrol, maintenance and public education to keep up with the traffic. The San Bernardino National Forest Association (SBNFA) and Adopt A Trail help with this important work, but funding is needed to maintain and expand these programs.

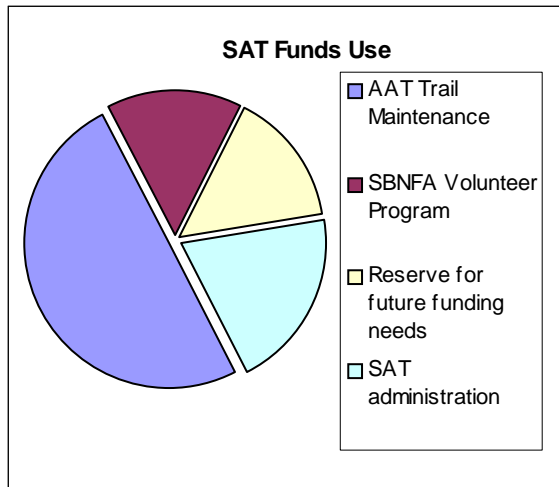
HOW YOU CAN HELP...
