San Bernardino National Forest to Offer “Fee Free” Days

San Bernardino, Calif., June 3, 2010 – San Bernardino National Forest announced that June 5-6 are “Fee Free” days for all visitors to the Forest. A National Forest Adventure Pass will not be required for visitors recreating in areas that require a National Forest Adventure Pass.

“This weekend marks National Trails Day, a great way to connect communities with public lands all over the country,” said San Bernardino National Forest Supervisor Jeanne Wade Evans. “This is a great opportunity to get outdoors and appreciate the open spaces while helping repair and maintain some of our trails here in southern California.”

“Fee Free” days are observed this year on:

National Trails Day - June 5-6
Back to School season - August 14-15
National Public Lands Day - September 25
Veterans’ Day - November 11

Visitors who inadvertently commit a Daily Adventure Pass for June 5-6 can have it replaced free-of-charge. However, Forest visitors are reminded that other fees such as campground, reservation and group site fees may still be applicable.

Visitors are encouraged to “*Know Before You Go*,” and to contact your local Ranger Station for more information on current conditions.
